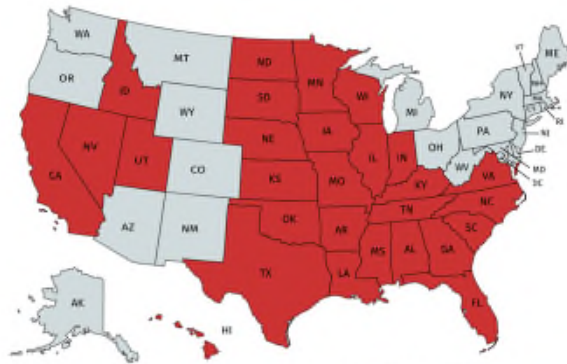

Elections

- Governor signs package of legislation expanding mail-in voting.
 - Potential for contracting COVID-19 considered illness for requesting absentee ballot.
- Executive Order 202.58:
 - All Boards of Election must send voters information regarding early voting, requesting an absentee ballot, etc.
 - Five-day cure period for deficiencies if received after November 3; must notify voters of the deficiency within 24 hours
